TEACHING TEAM

Our second grade classrooms have a dedicated core teacher and additional aides are available for support as needed.

CLASSROOM ENVIRONMENT

We strive to create a strong balance of nurturing and conductive learning in our classroom. A few ways that we achieve this is by emphasizing assigned seating, academic literacy and math centers, and student collaboration opportunities to maximize learning.

TEACHING APPROACH

Students are engaged in an integrated environment that allows multiple subjects to be explored at once.

- Inquiry-based learning
- Hands-on learning
- Differentiated instruction to focus on individual areas of growth that are unique to students.

CORE CURRICULUM

Second grade is designed to be rigorous and integrated to introduce new concepts in core subjects.

- Reading: Reading foundations, comprehension, context clues, etc.
- Writing: Penmanship, informative writing style, parts of speech, etc.
- Math: Number sense, computation, algebraic thinking, geometry, measurement, data analysis
- Social Studies: History, civics, geography, economics
- Bible: Relationships with the Creator, each other, ourselves, and creation

- ILEARN Standardized Testing, Spring


EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

DISCIPLINE

In second grade, students are expected to follow a seating chart, which is arranged quarterly. Our classroom expectations are that all students are treated with respect, and expected to reciprocate that respect right back to any adult. Students show respect by following directions, obeying the rules, and completing classroom assignments to the best of their ability. Classroom discipline will be given based on the offense, in order to keep the classroom running smoothly and effectively.
