#### **TEACHING TEAM**


For third grade, there are two elementary aides available as needed to support stations, reading groups, and other academic needs.

#### **CLASSROOM ENVIRONMENT**

The third grade classroom is designed to foster cooperation and collective learning. Stations can be easily transitioned to and pattern work due to seating partnerships. Safety measures are in place throughout the classroom and school to ensure students are aware of all expectations in regards to safety protocols and procedures.

### **TEACHING APPROACH**

The teaching approach in third grade is a fun combination of inquiry based learning and hands-on discovery. Students will use their critical thinking skills to perform tasks together and individually in diverse activities throughout units. Due to small class sizes, there is alway an opportunity for individualized attention as needed.



#### CORE CURRICULUM

Third grade is designed to be rigorous and integrated to introduce new concepts in core subjects.

- Reading: Reading foundations, comprehension, main ideas, fact vs. opinion, etc.
- Writing: Penmanship, persuasive writing style, narrative composition, writing process, etc.
- Math: Number sense, computation, algebraic thinking, geometry, measurement, data analysis
- Social Studies: History, civics, geography, economics
- Bible: Relationships with the Creator, each other, ourselves, and creation

### **TECHNOLOGY INTEGRATION**


Students are expected to utilize technology to complete assignments and engage with class content.

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### ASSESSMENT + PROGRESS TRACKING

We utilize a variety of methods to track student progress and keep parents engaged with their child's learning.

- IREAD Standardized Test preparation
- ILEARN Standardized Test
- Progress reports + report cards

In third grade, we want to expose kids to the learning that can happen inside and outside of the classroom through:


- Field trips

### DISCIPLINE


